Kindly refer to your letter No. F.3(2)(8)/2025/Affiliation/8411 dated 28.04.2025 on the subject cited above, forwarding the JAC report in respect of Sant Hari Dass College of Higher Education, (Opp. Air force Station) Bani Camp, Najafgarh, New Delhi-110043 for the issuance/revalidation of Provisional NOC for the Academic Session 2025-26 for the following courses/intakes under DHE:

As mentioned in the aforesaid letter dated 28.04.2025, the GGSIPU has examined the JAC report in respect of the above Institute. The same has been perused and it has been noticed that Part-I of the JAC report is more relevant in respect of land issues and statutory compliances of the institute and remaining Part-II & III of JAC report is related to academic matters including infrastructure and status of compliance with other terms and conditions pertaining to Institute. It is presumed that the JAC headed by Retd. Senior Officers, other subject experts and representative of University as members has seen and examined all the relevant documents/statutory clearances as per policy guidelines issued by this Directorate during the inspection and recommendations have been made in accordance with Policy Guidelines.

However, the JAC has made the following observations in respect of the aforesaid institute for compliance:

1. The fire fighting equipment need to be revalidated after 27.03.2025.
2. Two post of Associate Professor for BBA programme should be filled up on priority before the commencement of the programme.
3. Tactile pathways be provided for visually impaired students.
4. Books of foreign authors to be included in the library and more international journals be subscribed.
5. License software's be included with latest configuration of Computers.
6. Institute is advised to procure books of general interest such as books on freedom movements, economic strategies for development and novels etc.
7. Mock interviews to be incorporated for strengthening for placement prospects.
8. Institute needs to make sincere efforts for increasing the actual intake in both programmes.

Further, on the recommendations of the Scrutiny Committee dated 10.06.2025 and subsequent approval of the Hon'ble Minister (HE) for Grant of NOC to the existing institutions affiliated to GGSIPU running approved courses from the non-conforming area like lal dora/ extended lal dora/ school premises/ agricultural land and based on the recommendations of JAC and GGSIP University, the provisional NOC for the following courses under DHE for the Academic Year 2025-26 is granted to Sant Hari Dass College of Higher Education, subject to the following terms and conditions :

1. The Society/Institute shall abide by all the rules and regulations in force in Delhi by the Government, Local authorities and the affiliating University.
2. The Society / Institute shall follow the fee structure prescribed by the University/ Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
3. If it comes to the knowledge of Govt. of NCT of Delhi that the NOC has obtained by giving any false or misleading information or by concealing or suppressing any material facts or information, the NOC granted shall be withdrawn/ cancelled.
4. The University shall monitor compliance of the terms & conditions on a quarterly basis. If it is found during the course of monitoring of the compliance of the terms & conditions of grant of NOC, that the institute has not complied with these terms & conditions, the University may take penal action against the institute after following proper legal procedure.
5. The University may ensure the space norms prescribed by the Statutory Authorities/University/AICTE/UGC etc. are complied with.
6. The Institute/University shall strictly follow the policy guidelines prescribed by Directorate of Higher Education, GNCT of Delhi vide letters dated 12.01.2016, 03.02.2017 & 10.06.2021 in letter and spirit.
7. All the statutory compliances and removal of all other deficiencies/ shortcomings/suggestions noticed in the JAC report must be complied with by the concerned institute latest by 30th September, 2025. It is emphasized that the required precaution be taken immediately and all deficiencies removed in the given time frame failing which appropriate action as per guidelines/policy should be taken by GGSIPU under intimation to the Department.
8. The GGSIP University must ensure the compliance of the same within stipulated time period.
